Operational Policy # 5

C2C Mission House

Lifestreams Christian Church is very fortunate to own a three bedroom house in East Victoria Park. This house is specifically setup for C2C Workers and other missionaries to use while in Perth on furlough, sabbatical or sick leave.

Who can use the House?

- Wherever possible first preference will be given to the C2C Family.
- Any Christian Worker* currently serving with a Christian Mission Organisation.
- C2C Workers and other missionaries finishing their commitment can use the house for up to 3 months provided it is not needed by a current serving missionary.
- Children (over 18yrs) of serving missionaries who are studying in Perth can apply to use the house.
- Non - Missionaries* can apply to use the house if it is vacant. Applicants will be individually assessed by the C2C Leadership team. Non - Missionaries can only rent in three month blocks.

Administration

- Rent for serving C2C Workers or other missionaries is nominal at \$135 per week for a single person and \$155 per week for a family**, including telephone line rental, power, electricity and gas. Phone calls are invoiced separately.
- Rental for any non-missionary will be negotiated according to individual circumstances.
- Bookings, maintenance and all tenant requests are handled by the C2C Mission House Coordinator.
- Invoicing for the mission house is also handled by the C2C Mission House Coordinator.
- All accounts and maintenance costs are paid from Missions House Funds which are part of the Lifestreams Christian Church Missions Trust Account.
- The Mission House is insured under LCC's building insurance agreement.
- Tenants are required to adhere to all guidelines set out in the "C2C Missions House Handbook".

* The C2C Team will assess the suitability of all applicants on an individual basis
