Professor Abraham Joshua Heschel

It is said that this great Jewish teacher would encourage his students to live through each day with the intention of taking nothing for granted.

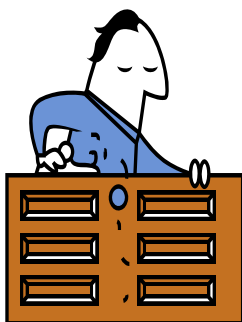
